NOTICE RE SWIMMING POOL

MAY 10, 2003

- The contract for operating the Jackson Court swimming pool has been awarded to the company, H2O, again this year.
- The pool is scheduled to open on June 14, and the last day of swimming will be on September 1.
- Hours of operation of the pool will be as follows:

June 14 to June 27

August 1 to August 15

August 16 to September 1

Daily:	12.00 noon to 4.30 pm.	Swimming

* Note: The last 30 mins. of swimming during weekdays between June 27 and September 1 will be for adults only.

- As requested by unit owners many times in the past, the Board is going to issue ID cards to residents this year, in an effort to improve control on use of the pool by non-residents. Each unit owner will be issued with one laminated ID card that must be used by residents to gain entry to the pool. If the ID card is lost, it will be replaced by the Property Manager at a cost of \$10.00. Temporary cards may be obtained from Board Directors until the replacement cards are available.
- Jackson Court residents aged 12-17 years can sign in up to two (2) guests per day. Adult residents (18 years and over) can sign in up to six (6) guests per day. Residents will have priority use of the pool (i.e. if the number of people in the

pool area exceeds 30 - the maximum for JC pool – guests will be asked to leave first to make room for residents).

- Adults are asked to introduce guests to the life guard at every visit. Please be responsible about the numbers and frequency of guest visits, so that this allowance to invite guests is not abused.
- The regular pool rules and health rules for this summer are attached. These will be posted on large notice Boards within the pool area. Please ensure all family members are familiar with the rules.
- Swimming lessons will be arranged again this year by lifeguards working for H2O, the pool contractor. The time allocated for lessons will be the same as last year.
- Adult swim times – Please note above that the last half hour of swimming time from Monday to Friday between June 27 and September 1 will be dedicated to adult swimmers.

SWIMMING POOL RULES – 2003

1. **PROPER BATHING SUITS ONLY MUST BE WORN (NO SHORTS).**
2. **SHOWERS MUST BE TAKEN BEFORE ENTERING WATER.**
3. **CHILDREN UNDER 12 YRS. MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT 18 YRS. OR OVER WITH PROPER I/D.**
4. **NO ANIMALS, TOYS OR DIVING GEAR ALLOWED.**
5. **ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION CARD.**
6. **FLOATATION DEVICES ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL, AND FRISBEES, BALLS, ETC. ARE PROHIBITED.**
7. **ALL BATHERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE LIFEGUARDS REQUEST TO CONTROL THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN THE POOL AND ON THE DECK.**
8. **RESIDENTS HAVE PRIORITY WHEN LIMIT OF 30 PERSONS HAS BEEN REACHED.**
9. **ANYONE NOT COMPLYING WITH THESE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE POOL AT THE LIFEGUARDS DISCRETION .**

SWIMMING POOL HEALTH REGULATIONS - 2003

1. NO PERSONS WITH COMMUNICABLE DISEASES OR OPEN SORES ON THEIR BODY SHALL ENTER THE SWIMMING POOL.
2. NO PERSONS SHALL POLLUTE THE WATER IN THE POOL IN ANY MANNER. SPITTING, SPOUTING OF WATER AND BLOWING YOUR NOSE IN THE POOL OR ON THE DECK ARE PROHIBITED.
3. NO PERSON SHALL ENGAGE IN BOISTEROUS PLAY IN OR ABOUT THE POOL.
4. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF BATHERS PERMITTED ON THE DECK AND IN THE POOL IS 30.
5. THE NEAREST EMERGENCY TELEPHONE IS LOCATED AT THE POOLHOUSE.
6. PROPER SWIMMING DIAPERS MUST BE USED ON BABIES.
7. NO SMOKING, DRINKING (EXCEPT SMALL PLASTIC WATER BOTTLES), GLASS CONTAINERS OR FOOD ALLOWED IN POOL AREA.
8. THE LIFEGUARD MUST BE OBEYED PROMPTLY AND AT ALL TIMES.
